Six Week Closure of Eastbound Lakeview Avenue Off-ramp

Background

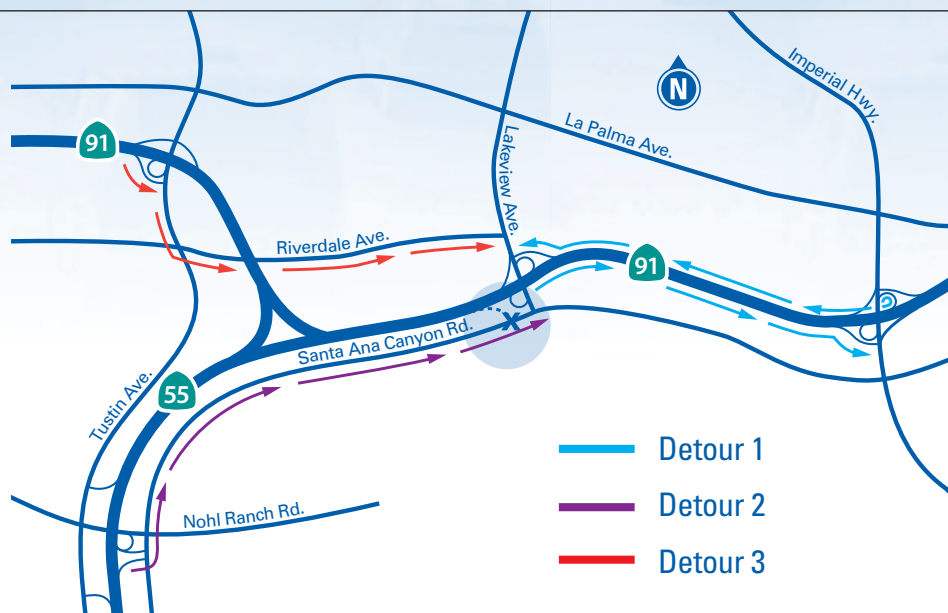
Caltrans and OCTA are adding a new six-mile lane in both the westbound and eastbound direction of SR-91 from approximately SR-55 to SR-241. The project will benefit commuters by increasing capacity, improving operations and relieving congestion, as well as delivering a better drive through Anaheim and Yorba Linda.

What: The Eastbound Lakeview Off-Ramp will be temporarily closed so that construction crews can safely and efficiently realign the ramp and accommodate the new lane.

When: Closure scheduled from January 9, 2012 to Friday, February 17, 2012.

Next Steps: Electronic signage will be erected. Concrete safety barriers will be installed and detour signs will be featured throughout the area.
